Job Description/Requirements

- Normal work hours are 7:00 AM to 3:30 PM M-F. But you must be able to work shift work which includes 1 to 2
 weekends per month. Be able to work overtime as needed. This may include answering on-call plant alarms during
 the hours of 3:30 P.M. to 7:00 A.M. or unplanned weekend work as deemed necessary by the plant supervisor.
- Operate, maintain, and perform preventative maintenance on all wastewater treatment plant processes. This may
 include working in harsh weather conditions, lifting items that may weigh 75 to 100 pounds, climbing ladders on
 tanks that are 33 feet high, cutting grass, cleaning tanks and operating machinery (skid loaders, forklifts, boom or
 man lifts). Maintenance items include changing drive chains & belts, changing oil, pulling pumps and aerators,
 minor electrical troubleshooting and other tasks as deemed necessary by the plant supervisor.
- Perform laboratory testing including total & free chlorine residuals, pH, Dissolved Oxygen, Fecal Coliform, Solids
 Settleabilty, Total Suspended Solids, Total & Solids, Nitrate, Ammonia and any other testing which may be
 necessary for compliance or plant operations.
- Be able to perform data entry on computers. Be able to use smartphone and tablet/ipad applications including doforms and splashtop. Data is stored in WIMS database software by Hach Company.
- Perform manual labor and housekeeping tasks. This may include landscaping, painting, janitorial tasks, shoveling sludge/grit/screenings, power washing, steam cleaning or whatever is deemed necessary by the Treatment Plant Supervisor.
- In this job you will get dirty, expect this. But you will be given personal protective equipment, uniforms, coveralls and whatever is needed to maintain a safe working environment for you.
- Become qualified and pass the D-level certification test for Biological Wastewater within 1-year of hire date.

 Once trained and certified, be able to work with minimum supervision.
- There is 90-day probationary period
